An Ordinance Relevying and Reassessing on Certain Lots and Parcels of Ground in the City of Wathena, Kansas, a portion of the cost of grading, pavin, curbing, guttering and otherwise

Said bonds shall be signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk of Said City and shall have impressed thereon the corporate seal of the said City and said coupons shall be authenticated by the lithographed or actual signatures of said Mayor and City Clerk. Said bonds shall be payable serially as above provided at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Kansas, at Topeka, Kansas and said Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to deliver bonds and coupons to.....which has purchased said bonds under a contract therefor and on the payment of the purchase price according to the terms of the said contract, and for the payment of said bonds and interest thereon annual levies shall be made as provided by law on all property liable therefor.

Sec. 2. Said bonds shall be in substantially the following form, with recitals, as follows:

WATERWORKS BOND.

KNOW ALL MEN BE THESE PRESENTS, That the City of Wathena in the County of Doniphan, State of Kansas, for value received hereby acknowledges itself to be indebted and promises to pay to the bearer, the sum of Dollars in lawful money of the United States of America on the 15th day of 19...With interest thereon at the rate of 4 3/4 percent per annum, payable semi-annually on the 15th day of January and July of each year after the date hereof until the principal sum shall have been paid, upon the presentation and surrender of the proper interest coupons hereto attached, bearing the facsimile signature of the Mayor and City Clerk of said City as they severally become due, the first interest coupon becoming due.....Both principal and interest are payable at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Kansas, City of Topeka, Kansas, and the City of Wathena is held and firmly bound and its faith and credit and all real and personal property in said City are hereby pledged for the prompt payment of the interest and principal of this bond as they are severally due.

This bond is one of a series of 45 bonds of like date, tenor and effect, except denominations and maturity and numbered from One to Forty-Six inclusive, aggregating the sum of \$41,000.00 issued by the City of Wathena, Kans., for the purpose of paying the construction of water works in the said city and improving Doniphan Street between Fremont and Benton Streets, and Jessie Street between Creel and Moss Streets and Benton Street and Bryan Street between Jessie and Benton Streets and Creel Street between Court Street and St. Joseph Streets, and Court Street between Doniphan and Stewart Streets and Stewart Street between Court Street and St. Joseph Street, and Providing for the Collection and Payment of such assessments;

Whereas; The City of Wathena, Kansas, has heretofore caused to be graded, paved, curbed and guttered and otherwise improved that part of Doniphan Street between Fremont Street and Benton Street, of Jessie Street between Creel Street and Moss Street, of Bryan Street between Jessie Street and Benton Street, of Creel Street between Court Street and St. Joseph Street, of Court Street between Doniphan Street and Stewart Street and of Stewart Street between Court Street and St. Joseph Street, and the total cost of said improvement has been ascertained and

Whereas; By Ordinance No. 103 of said City of Wathena, Kansas, that portion of said cost of said improvements to be paid by special assessments upon the lots and pieces of ground liable therefor was levied, assessed, apportioned on the various lots and pieces of ground in said ordinance described, and

Whereas; Certain of the special assessments so levied may have been informal, illegal or void for want of sufficient authority in the Mayor and Councilmen of said City in causing such improvement to be made, or for other cause or causes, and

Whereas, By virtue of the provisions of statutes of the State of Kansas including Section 14-104 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923, the Mayor and Councilmen of said City of Wathena, Kansas, are authorized and empowered to relevy and reassess any such assessments or taxes which may be informal, illegal or void for want of sufficient authority or other cause;

Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilment of the City of Wathena, Kansas.

Sec. 1. For the purpose of paying a portion of the cost of grading, paving, curbing, guttering and otherwise improving that part of Doniphan Street between Freemont Street and Benton Street, of Jessie Street between Creel Street and Moss Street, of Bryan Street between Jessie Street and Benton Street, of Creel Street between Court Street and St. Joseph Street, of Creel Street between Doniphan Street and Stewart Street and of Stewart Street between Court Street and St. Joseph Street, all in the City of Wathena, Kansas there is hereby relieved and reassessed on the various lots and pieces of ground hereinafter described, special assessments covering the respective portions of the cost of improving said parts of said streets taxable to said lots and pieces of ground respectively, the said special assessments so relieved and reassessed being based on the special apraisment and valuation of all of the lots and pieces of ground liable to pay a portion of the cost of making such improvement beretofore made in the manner provided by law, and the several amounts so relieved and reassessed against said lots and pieces of ground as follows:
