

Ordinance No. 11

Providing for and Requiring Sidewalks to be Laid and Constructed
on the Various Streets of the City of Wathena.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

Section 1. That good, substantial sidewalks, of the first class, as provided in ordinance No. 12, be built and constructed on the north and south sides of St. Joseph Street, between Moss and Creal Streets, said sidewalks to be not less than ten feet wide and of uniform grade and surface.

Section 2. That good, substantial sidewalks, of the second class be built of uniform grade and surface, and kept in good repair on the following streets of said City of Wathena, to-wit: On the west side of Bryan Street, on the west side of Moss Street, west side of Doniphan Street and west side of Creal Street said sidewalks shall be not less than four feet wide, except when permission is given by the City Council for good reasons to change this width and shall be built constructed and repaired in accordance with ordinance No. 12.

Section 3. That good and substantial sidewalks of the third class, shall be built, maintained and kept in good repair on the following streets of said City of Wathena, to-wit: On Mill, Limestone, Freemont, Jesse, Benton, Seward, Chase and Sherman Streets and said sidewalks shall be not less than three feet wide, of uniform grade and surface and shall be built, maintained and repaired as reruired and provided in said ordinance No. 12.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and publication in pamphlet form.
