

Ordinance 115.

As Ordinance authorizing the issuance of internal improvement bonds of the City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas in the sum of \$39,347.00 for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing a sewer system for said City and Repealing Ordinance 114.

Whereas, in pursuance of proceedings duly had and taken by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, a contract has heretofore been let for the construction of a sewer system in and near and for the benefit of said City; all in accordance with Ordinance of said City and numbered 108 and 109, and duly and legally passed and approved by the Mayor and Councilmen of Said City, and

Whereas, Said sewer system has been constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications of the City Engineers duly approved by the Mayor and Councilmen of the said City, and the total cost of said improvement has been and is hereby ascertained to be in the sum of \$39,347., and that all of said cost has been and is hereby charged against the property, real and personal in said City, and

Whereas, All legal requirements have been duly complied with to authorize the issuance of the bonds of said City for the payment of the cost of said improvement in the said sum of \$39,347.00 and it has been and is hereby determined necessary to issue the bonds of said City in said sum to secure funds with which to pay the cost of said improvement.

Now therefore be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, as follows:

Sec. 1. That for the purpose of providing funds with which to pay the cost of constructing a sewer system for the City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, the boundaries of said sewer system for the City of Wathena, as provided for in the Ordinance No. 108, published on the sixth day of May, 1926, there shall be issued and hereby are issued a series of Internal Improvement Bonds of said City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, aggregating the principal sum of \$39,347.00. Said series shall consist of 40 bonds numbered from 1 to 40 inclusive, one of said bonds being in the sum of \$347.00 and 39, of said bonds being the sum of \$1,000.00 each. All of said bonds shall be dated the 1st day of February, 1927 and shall become due as follows:

Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of 4 3/4 percent per annum, payable semi-annually, on February 1st and August 1st, in each year except that the first interest coupon shall represent one year's interest and shall become due on the first day of February, 1928. Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeka, Kansas.

Sec. 2. Said bonds shall be signed by the Mayor of said city and shall be attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City. There shall be attached to said bonds interest coupons bearing the lithographed signatures of said Mayor and City Clerk. Each of said bonds and interest coupons shall be in substantially the following form:

Know all men by these presents: That the City of Wathena, in the County of Doniphan, State of Kansas, for value received, hereby acknowledges itself to be indebted and promises to pay to the bearer hereof the sum of

One Thousand Dollars

in lawful money of the United States of America, on the first day of February, (August), 1928, with interest thereon at the rate of 4 3/4 percent per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of February and August in each year after the date hereof until said principal sum shall have been paid, the first interest coupon coming due the 1st day of February 1928, upon presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto annexed, bearing the lithographed signatures of the Mayor and City Clerk of said City as said coupon severally become due both principal and interest of said bond being payable at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeka, Kansas. And said City of Wathena, Doniphan County Kansas, is held and firmly bound by these presents and its faith and credit and all of the real and personal property in said City are hereby pledged for the prompt payment of said principal and interest at maturity.

The bond is one of a series of 40 bonds of like and tenor, excepting denominations and maturity aggregating the principal sum of \$39,347.00, issued by the City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas for the purpose of paying the cost of sewer system for all of said city by authority of and in full compliance with the provisions, restrictions and limitations of the Constitution and Laws of the State of Kansas, including Sections 12-617 to 12-631 inclusive of the Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923, and all other provisions of the laws of said State applicable thereto and this bond and all of the other bonds of said series, and all interest thereon, are to be paid by the City of Wathena, Kansas.

And it is declared and certified that all acts, conditions and things required to be done and to exist precedent to and in the issuance of this bond have been properly done and performed and to exist in due and regular form and manner as required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Kansas, and that the total indebtedness of said City, including this series of bonds, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitations.

In Witness Whereof, the said City of Wathena, County of Doniphan, State of Kansas, by its Mayor and Councilmen has caused this bond to be signed by its Mayor and its appropriate seal to be thereto affixed, attested by its City Clerk and the coupons hereto attached to be signed with the lithographed signatures of said officers, and this bond to be dated this 1st day of February, 1927.
