

Ordinance 121.

An ordinance establishing a grade for Sidewalks on Bryant street between Mill and Limestone Streets and fixing the time for building Sidewalks thereon.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Wathena, Kansas:

Section 1- That the grade of Bryant Street in the original Town, now City of Wathena, Kansas, between Mill and Limestone Streets, be and is hereby established for the purpose of building, rebuilding, and reconstructing sidewalks thereon as follows: Beginning at the southeast Corner of Block eight (8) and the Southwest corner of Block nine (9) at grade elevation 831.00 at each of said Block eight (8) and the northwest corner of said Block nine (9) at the grade elevation of 838.80 ft.

Section 2- That the Sidewalk mentioned in Ordinance number one Hundred and Twenty of the City of Wathena, Kansas, be reconstructed by the owner of the lot or lots fronting or abutting on the same within twenty days from the publication of this Ordinance.

Section 3- That if said sidewalk is not reconstructed within said time by the owner of said lot or lots aforesaid the City of Wathena by its proper authorities will proceed according to law to reconstruct said Sidewalk.
