

Ordinance No. 127

AN ORDINANCE LEVING RAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUES FOR THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS FOR THE YEAR OF 1932.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the city of Wathena, Kansas:

Section 1. That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray the current expenses of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1932, there be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property (except when otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Wathena, Kansas, taxes as follows for the purposes indicated such taxes being represented by mills and fractions of mills on the dollar.

Bonds and Interest ----- 31.75 Mills

To pay all accrued and accruing interest and principle on internal improvement bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of paying for the construction of watherworks system, main and frainage sewers, paving and grading intersections and payment of refunding bonds.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas, is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the county clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas on or before August 25, 1932, to be placed on the tax rolls of the year 1932, for collection as provided by law.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it's publication in the Wathena Times.
