

Ordinance # 129.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUES FOR THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS FOR THE YEAR 1933.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Wathena, Kansas:

Section 1. That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray the current expenses of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1933, there be and hereby levied upon all taxable property (except when otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Wathena, Kansas, taxes as follows for the purposes indicated such taxes being represented by mills and fractions of mills on the dollar.

Bonds and Interest ----- 39 Mills.

To pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on internal improvement bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of paying for the construction of waterworks system, main and drainage sewers, paving and grading intersections and payment of refunding bonds.

Section 2. That the city clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas, is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas on or before August 25, 1933, to be placed on the tax rolls of the year 1933, for collection as provided by law.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Wathena Times.
