

Ordinance 133

An Ordinance levying taxes for the purpose of providing revenue for the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1936.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Wathena Kansas:

Section 1 - That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray the current expenses of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1936, there be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property (except as otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Wathena Kansas, taxes as follows for the purpose indicated such taxes being represented by mills and fractions of mills on the dollar:

General Fund ---Three Mills

Bonds and Interest--30.3 Mills.

To pay all accrued and accruing interest and principle on internal improvement bonds issues by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of paying for the construction of Watherworks, main and drainage sewers, paving and grading intersections and payment of refunding funds.

Section 2- That the City clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the County clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas on or before August 25, 1936, to be placed on the tax rolls of the year 1936, for collection as provided by law.

Section 3- That the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Wathena Times.
