

Ordinance 135

An ordinance Relating to Motor Vehicles and Regulating their operation and parking and providing a penalty for the violation of this ordinance

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Wathena, Kansas:

Section 1 - That section 5 of Ordinance # 95 of the City of Wathena passed and approved on the first day of July, 1924 be and is hereby repealed.

Section 2 - No person shall operate a motor vechile on the streets or alleys of said city except on the right side of said street or alley except at an intersection of a street or alley with another street.

Section 3 - Vechiles, on St. Joseph street between Doniphan and Moss Streets, shall be parked at an angle to the curb indicated by such marks or signs, except when unloading passengers or merchandise and then only for a period of time not to exceed five minutes, providing that no part of any vechile, its contents or load shall be a greater distance than twelve feet from the curb when parked.

Section 4 - Parking a vechile on the East side of Doniphan street from Mill street to Fremont Street shall be prohibited.

Section 5 - Unlawful Parking: No person shall stand or park a vechile on any street for the principle purpose of:

- A - Displaying it for sale.
- B - Washing, greasing or repairing such vechile, except repairs necessitated by an emergency.
- C - Parking for more than twelve hours continuously.
- D - The purpose of advertising.

Section 6 - No person shall stand or park a vechile within ten feet of a fire hydrant.

Section 7 - Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in a sum not less than one dollar and not more than Twenty Five Dollars.
