

Ordinance 136

An Ordinance Prescribing License Fees For Persons Selling Cereal Malt Beverages at Retail Within the City of Wathena, Kansas, Under the Provisions of House Bill No. 587 of the Laws of Kansas of 1937.

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Wathena, Kansas:

Section 1. The license fees of persons engaged in the retail sale of cereal malt beverages under the provisions of House Bill No. 587 of the laws of Kansas of 1937 within the City Limits of Wathena, Kansas, are hereby prescribed as follows:

- (a) For each place of business selling only at retail cereal malt beverages in original and unbroken case lots, and not for consumption on the premises, \$50.00 per calendar year.
- (b) For each other place of business selling cereal malt beverages at retail, \$50.00 per calendar year.

The full amount of the license fee shall be required regardless of the time of the year in which the application is made, and the licensee shall only be authorized to operate under the license for the remainder of the calendar year in which the license is issued.

The license shall be signed, attested, and countersigned by the officers charged by law to issue other licenses under the general licensing power of the city and shall be by order of the governing body.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after May 1, 1937, and its publication in the Wathena Times.
