

An Ordinance Relating to Street Obstruction

ORDIANCE NO. 138

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS.

Section One. It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct any pavement, street, alley or sidewalk in said city and in front of his or her premises by placing thereon any boxes, barrels, wood, merchandise or other thing or permit the same to be done.

Section Two. Every person so offending shall, upon conviction be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars and every day, after written notice given, that said obstruction shall be permitted to remain on said pavement, street, alley or sidewalk shall constitute a separate offense with like penalty.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the Wathena Times.
