

ORDINANCE NUMBER 144

An Ordinance levying taxes for the purpose of providing revenue for the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1940.

Section One: That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray current expenses of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1940, there be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property (except as otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Wathena, Kansas, taxes as follows for the purpose indicated, such taxes being represented by mill and fractions of mills on the dollar:

General Fund-----	2.58 Mills	
Street Fund-----	1.72 Mills	
Fire Dept. Fund-----	.81 Mills	
Street Lighting Fund-----	1.60 Mills	
Sewer Maintenance Fund-----	.40 Mills	
Bonds & Interest-----	11.70 Mills	to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principle on internal improvement bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of paying for the construction of Waterworks, Main and Drainage Sewers and the payment of Refunding Bonds.

Section Two: That the City clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas on or before August 25, 1939, to be placed on the tax rolls of the year 1939, for collection as provided by law.

Section Three: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Wathena Times.
