

ORDINANCE NUMBER 164

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUE FOR THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS FOR THE YEAR 1948.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Wathena, Kansas:

Section One: That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray current expenses of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1948, there be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property (except as otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Wathena, Kansas, taxes as follows for the purpose indicated, such taxes being represented by mills and fraction of mills on the dollar.

General Fund-----	1.34 Mills
Street Fund-----	2.56 Mills
Fire Department Fund-----	1.23 Mills
Street Lighting Fund-----	1.28 Mills
Sewer Maintenance Fund-----	.27 Mill
Municipal Bond Fund-----	.50 Mill
Bond & Interest Fund-----	4.19 Mills to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on internal improvement bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of paying for the extending and improving it's system of Water works.

Section Two: That the City Clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas on or before August 25, 1947, to be placed on the tax rolls of the year 1947, for collection as provided by law.

Section Three: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it's publication in the Wathena Times.
