## ORDINANCE NUMBER 166.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WATER RATES FOR THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS.

Whereas, In order to provide funds to pay increased cost of operation due to installation of Softener Plant at the Water Pumping Station, it is necessary to increase the Water Rate for water sold by the City of Wathena, Kansas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

Section One: Taht the following rates are hereby established for water consumers in the City of Wathena, Kansas: Minimum per month \$1.50 Two Thousand gallons included, excess at the rate of  $50\c$  per thousand gallons. Water purchased in tank lots and delivered at the City stand pipe to be sold at the rate of  $75\c$  per thousand gallons, with a minimum of  $50\c$  for any single tank lot delivery.

Section Two: This rate will be effective on February bills. (Bills due March 1, 1949, and all bills thereafter due while this Ordinance is in force.

Section Three: That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances now in force and conflicting with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Four: This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after it's adoption, approval and publication in the Wathena Times.
