

ORDINANCE NUMBER 181.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUE FOR THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS FOR THE YEAR 1952.

BE IT ORDAIND BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS.

SECTION ONE: That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray current expenses of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1952, there be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property (except as otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Wathena, Kansas, taxes as follows for the purpose indicated, such taxes being represented by mills and fraction of mills on the dollar.

General Operating Fund----- 7.748 Mills

Municipal Band Fund----- .318 Mill

Bond & Interest Fund----- 5.018 Mills to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on Waterworks Imrpovement Bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of paying for the improvements to it's system of Waterworks, and to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on Fire Department Equipment Bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of purchasing and/or replacing Fire Department Equipment.

SECTION TWO: That the City Clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas on or before August 25, 1951, to be placed on the tax rolls of the year 1951, for collection as provided by law.

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it's publication in the Wathena Times.
