

Ordinance No. 2.

In relation to the Time of Meeting of the
City Council.

Section 1. That the regular meetings of the City Council shall be held on the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of each month, at 7 o'clock, P.M. Special meetings may be called by the Mayor or acting Mayor, on the written request of any three members of the Council, specifying the object and purpose for which said meeting is to be called, and no other business shall be transacted in said meeting but that which is in the said request.

Section 2. The Marshall or his deputy shall attend the sessions of the City Council, and execute all orders of the board of Councilmen to him directed; keep the hall swept clean, make fires, light up, and do such other duties as he may be directed to perform by the Council.

Section 3. Any Councilman who absents himself from any meeting of the Council, without reasonable excuse, shall be liable to a fine of not less than fifty cents nor more than two dollars.

Section 4. All ordinances, petitions and communications to the City Council may, by a vote of the Council, be referred to a special or standing committee.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in pamphlet form.
