ORDINANCE NUMBER 202.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUE FOR THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS FOR THE YEAR 1956.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS.

SECTION ONE: That for the purpose of raising revenue todefray current expenses of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1956, there be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property (except as otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Wathena, Kansas, taxes as follows for the purpose indicated, such taxes being represented by mills and fraction of mills on the dollar.

General Operating Fund ----- 7.67 Mills ----- .31 Mill Muncipal Band Fund -----12,55 Mills Bond & Interest Fund to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on Waterworks Improvement Bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of paying for the improvements to it's system of Watherworks and to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on Fire Department Equipment Bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of purchasing and/or replacing Fire Department Equipment and to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on Internal Improvement (Street) Bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of Curbing, Guttering and otherwise improving both sides of Bryan Street from Jesse Street to the first alley south of Court Street; Moss Street from Jesse Street to St. Joseph Street, and North Side of St. Joseph Street from Moss Street to Katy Street (Except those Internal Improvement Bonds to be paid by Special Assessment.)

SECTION TWO: That the City Clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas on or before the 25th day of August, 1955, to be placed on the tax rolls of the year 1955, for collection as provided by law.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the Governing Body and its approval by the Mayor and its publication in the official City paper.
