

Ordinance No. 21

Providing for and requiring sidewalks to be laid, constructed and maintained on the various streets of the City of Wathena.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

Section 1. That good, substantial sidewalks of the first class, as provided in Ordinance No. 12, be built and constructed on the north and south sides of St. Joseph street, between Moss and Creal streets.

Section 2. That good, substantial sidewalks of the second or fourth class as the council may direct, be built on the following streets of the City of Wathena, to-wit: On the west side of Bryan Street, between St. Joseph Street and Benton Street; on the west side of Doniphan between St. Joseph street and Jessie street; on the west side of Creal street, between Mill street and Benton street.

Section 3. That good, substantial sidewalks of the third or fifth class as the council may direct, shall be built on all the streets of the City of Wathena except as otherwise provided for in section one and section two of this ordinance.

Section 4. That all sidewalks provided for in this ordinance shall be built of uniform grade and surface, and maintained and kept in good repair by the owners of the property adjoining same as provided No. 12.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the mayor and publication in The Wathena Republican and the Wathena Times.
