ORDINANCE NO. 213

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS IN NORTH WATHENA,
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA;

Sec. 1. That the portion or part of the streets and alleys in North Wathena, an Addition to the original town, now City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, according to plat dated August 26, 1899 and recorded September 12, 1899, in Plat Book B at page 56 in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Doniphan County, Kansas, as hereinafter described be vacated:

- (a) The West Twenty (20) feet of Race Street from its intersection with the South line of Sherman Street on the North to its intersection with the North line of Seward Street on the South.
- (b) Chase Street from its intersection with the West line of Race Street on the East (the West line of Race Street being as established in preceding paragraph) to its intersection with Harding Avenue on the West.
- (c) Vine Street from its intersection with Harding Avenue on the South to its intersection with the South line of Sherman Street on the North.
- (d) The East-West alleys through blocks Forty-four (44), Forty-six (46), and Forty-seven (47).

Sec.2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Wathena Times on January 28, 1960.
