

ORDINANCE NUMBER 214.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUE FOR THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS FOR THE YEAR 1961.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray current expenses of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1961, there be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property (except as otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Wathena, Kansas, taxes as follows for the purpose indicated, such taxes being represented by mills and fraction of mills on the dollar.

General Operating Fund----- 8.20 Mills

Municipal Band----- .31 Mill

Bond & Interest Fund----- 5.90 Mills

to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on Waterorks Improvement Bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of paying for the improvements to it's system of Waterworks and to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on Internal Improvement (Street) Bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of Curbing, Guttering and otherwise improving both sides of Bryan Street from Jesse Street to first alley south of Court Street; Moss Street from Jesse Street to St. Joseph Street and North side of St. Joseph Street from Moss Street to Katy Street (except those Internal Improvement Bonds to be paid by Special Assessment.)

SECTION TWO: That the City Clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas of or before the 25th day of August, 1960, to be placed on the tax rolls of the year 1960, for collection as provided by law.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after it's passage by the Governing Body and it's approval by the Mayor and it's publication in the official City Paper.

Passed by the Governing Body and approved by the Mayor this 16th day of August, 1960.
