

ORDINANCE NUMBER 221.

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE WHO FREQUENT CERTAIN CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: That from and after the effective date of this ordinance no person under the age of eighteen (18) years shall frequent or be found in any place of business or establishment in the City of Wathena, Kansas, which is engaged primarily in the sale and dispensation of Cereal Malt Beverages (3.2 %) beer and commonly known as a tavern after the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., unless accompanied by his or her parent or legal guardian.

SECTION TWO: That all persons violating this ordinance, shall upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00.

SECTION THREE: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: That this ordinance shall become final and take effect from and after its publication in the official city paper.
