

AN ORDINANCE ANNULLING, VACATING AND DISCONTINUING CRAWFORD STREET IN SMALLWOOD'S ADDITION, TO THE ORIGINAL TOWN, NOW CITY OF WATHENA, DONIPHAN COUNTY, KANSAS;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Wathena, Kansas, has deemed it necessary and expedient to annul, discontinue, and legally vacate the herein-after described Street:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA:

SECTION 1. That the hereinafter described Street situate in Smallwood's Addition to the original Town, now City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, to wit:

That part of Crawford Street (60 feet wide) which is described as follows: Beginning at the North-east corner of Lot 1 in Block 3 in Smallwood's aforesaid Addition, thence South to the Southeast corner of Lot 12 in Block 6 in Smallwood's aforesaid Addition, thence East 60 feet, thence North to a point 60 feet East of the point of beginning, thence West 60 feet to the point of beginning.

be and the same is hereby annulled, discontinued, and legally vacated.

SECTION 2. That immediately after this Ordinance shall become effective, the City Clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas shall file a copy thereof, which has been duly certified by him as a true and correct copy, in the office of the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas, and in the office of the Register of Deeds of Doniphan County, Kansas, as is required by the provisions of Section 15-427, 1961 Supplement to the General Statutes of Kansas for 1949.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance and the annulment, discontinuance, and legal vacation of the above described Street shall be effective from and after the publication of said Ordinance in the WATHENA TIMES, official City paper.
