

Ordinance No. 237

An Ordinance Prescribing Rules and Regulations Concerning the Moral, Sanitary and Health Conditions of Places Licensed to Sell Cereal Malt Beverage at Retail in the City of Wathena and Prescribing a Penalty for the Violation Thereof.

Be It Ordained By the Governing Body of the City of Wathena:

Section 1. That all cereal malt beverages sold at retail in the City of Wathena for consumption on the licensed premises through which the same was sold and delivered shall be consumed within an all weather building located on said premises and consumption of cereal malt beverages on said licensed premises on the outside of the building located thereon is hereby prohibited.

Section 2. That any person holding such license to sell cereal malt beverage at retail as herein provided who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall have his said license revoked as provided by law.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its publication in the official city paper.
