AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DANCING IN ANY PLACE OF BUSINESS WHEREIN CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES ARE LICENSED TO BE SOLD, AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA:

SECTION 1. As used in this Ordinance, the words and phrases in this

Section defined shall have the following meaning:

- (a) "Place of Business" shall mean any place at which cereal malt beverages are licensed to be sold.
- (b) "Person" shall mean: (1) any cereal malt beverage license,
 (2) any agent or employee of a cereal malt beverage license,
 and (3) any owner of the premises in which a place of business is located.

c) "Dancing" shall mean any RHYTHMIC movement of the feet or body, either accompanied by music.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to authorize or permit

dancing in any place of business in the City of Wathena, Kansas.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or by a fine in any sum not exceeding One-Hundred (\$100.00) and No/100 Dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Wathena Times, official City paper.
