

ORDINANCE NUMBER 250

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUE FOR THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, FOR THE YEAR 1967.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray current expenses of the City of Wathena, Kansas, for the year 1967, there be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property (except as otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Wathena, Kansas, taxes as follows for the purpose indicated, such taxes being represented by mills and fraction of mills on the dollar.

General Operating Fund----- 6.82 Mills  
Bond & Interest Fund----- 2.12 Mills  
to pay all accrued and accruing interest and principal on Waterworks Improvement Bonds issued by the City of Wathena, Kansas for the purpose of paying for the Improvements to it's system of Waterworks.

SECTION TWO: That the City Clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas, is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas, on or before the 25th day of August, 1966, to be placed on the tax rolls of the year 1966, for collection as provided by law.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after it's passage by the Governing Body, it's approval by the Mayor and it's publication in the Official City Paper.

Passed by the Governing Body and approved by the Mayor this 16th day of August, 1966.
