

ORDINANCE NO. 279

AN ORDINANCE ANNULING, VACATING AND DISCONTINUING PART OF BRYAN STREET IN NORTH WATHENA AN ADDITION TO THE ORIGINAL TOWN, NOW CITY OF WATHENA, DONIPHAN COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Wathena deems it necessary and expedient to legally vacate and discontinue the herein described street:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA:

SECTION 1. The hereinafter described portion of Bryan (3rd) Street situate in North Wathena, an addition to the Original Town, now City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, to wit:

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of Block 52, thence South 300 feet to the Southeast Corner of Block 52, thence East 60 feet to the Southwest Corner of Block 53, thence North 300 feet to the Northwest Corner of Block 53, thence West 60 feet to point of beginning,

be and the same is hereby annulled, discontinued and legally vacated.

SECTION 2. Immediately after this Ordinance shall become effective, the City Clerk shall file a certified, true and correct copy thereof in the Offices of the County Clerk and the Register of Deeds of Doniphan County, Kansas, in the manner required by K.S.A. 15-427.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance and the annulment, discontinuance and legal vacation of the herein described street shall be effective from and after its publication in THE WATHENA TIMES, official City paper.
