

ORDINANCE NO. 287

AN ORDINANCE ANNULING, VACATING AND DISCONTINUING A PORTION OF ST. JOSEPH STREET IN CREAL'S ADDITION, TO THE ORIGINAL TOWN, NOW CITY OF WATHENA, DONIPHAN COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Wathena, Kansas, has deemed it necessary and expedient to annul, discontinue and legally vacate the herein-after described portion of St. Joseph Street:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA:

SECTION ONE. That the hereinafter described portion of St. Joseph Street situate in Creal's Addition to the original town, now City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, to wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot Thirteen (13), Block Twenty-six (26) in Creal's Addition to the Original Town, now City of Wathena, thence North eighty (80) feet to the north side of St. Joseph Street, thence East along the north side of said street to the west side of the existing railroad rights-of-way, thence Southeasterly along the west side of the existing railroad right-of-way to the South side of St. Joseph Street; thence West, along the south side of St. Joseph Street to the point of beginning,

be and the same is hereby annulled, discontinued and legally vacated, subject, however, to the provisions of Section Two of this Ordinance.

SECTION TWO. The City of Wathena reserves a right for water lines, sewage lines, natural gas lines, electrical power lines and any and all other public utilities and rights-of-way and easements as, in the future, may, in the judgment of the Governing Body of the City of Wathena, be necessary or desirable for public service.

SECTION THREE. That immediately after this Ordinance shall become effective, the City Clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas, shall file a copy thereof, which has been duly certified by him as a true and correct copy, in the office of the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas, and in the office of the Register of Deeds of Doniphan County, Kansas, as is required by the provisions of K.S.A. 15-427.

SECTION FOUR. That this Ordinance and the annulment, discontinuance, and legal vacation of the above described Street shall be effective from and after publication of said Ordinance in THE WATHENA TIMES, official City paper.
