

ORDINANCE NO. 397

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALES PRICE OR RATES FOR ELECTRICITY SOLD BY THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, TO CUSTOMERS OF SAID CITY AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 167.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA:

SECTION 1. RATES. The following monthly rates and charges are hereby established for electricity sold by the City to cutomers served by the City:

- (a). A minimum monthly charge of Two and 10/100 Dollars (\$2.00) per month, which minimum charge shall include and pay for the first 5 K.W.H.
- (b). For the next 45 K.W.H. the sum of Five Cents (\$.05) per K.W.H.
- (c). For the next 350 K.W.H. the sum of Three Cents (\$.03) per K.W.H.
- (d) For each K.W.H. in excess of 400 K.W.H. the sum of Two Cents (\$.02).

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. The rates established by this Ordinance shall be effective for all electricity sold and delivered by the City pursuant to all of the foregoing sections from and after January 1, 1974.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. Ordinance No. 167 of the City of Wathena is hereby repealed.
