ORDINANCE NO. 303

AN ORDINANCE ESTALDISHING RATES AND SALES PRICE FOR ELECTRICITY SOLD AND DELIVERED BY THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, TO CUSTOMERS OF SAID CITY, PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF A FUEL ADJUSTMENT FACTOR IN COMPUTING RATES AND CHARGES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 307 OF THE CITY OF WATHENA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MATHEMA:

SECTION 1. RATES AND CHARGES. The following monthly rates and charges are hereby established for electricity sold by the City of Wathena to customers served by the City (as used below the term "K.W.H." means kilowatt hour):

- (a). A minimum monthly charge of Two and No/100 Dollars (\$2.00) per month, which minimum charge shall include and pay for the first 5 K.V.II.
- (b). For the next 45 K.W.H. the sum of Five Cents (\$.05) per K.W.H.
- (c). For the next 350 K.W.H. the sum of Three Cents (\$.03) per K.W.H.
- (d). For each K.W.H. in excess of 400 K.W.H. the sum of Two Cents (\$.02).

In addition to the foregoing charge for total K.W.H. consumed by each cutomer during any monthly period, such customers shall be billed for and shall pay the monthly Fuel Adjustment Charge established and provided for in Section two below.

SECTION 2. FUEL ADJUSTMENT CHARGE. In addition to the charge per K.W.H. provided for in the rate schedule set forth in Section One above, each electric customer of the City of Wathena shall pay a monthly fuel adjustment charge for the electricity consumed by such customer during the period for which the customer is billed in an amount equal to the total K.W.H. consumed by the customer during the period for which billed multiplied by the fuel adjustment factor, if any, used by The Kansas Power and Light Company (such company being the supplier of all electric energy to the City for resale by the City to its customers) in computing the amount of the City's bill for all electric energy furnished by said Power Company to the City during that billing period of the Power Company which is next last past prior to the date on which the City bills its customers. Such fuel adjustment charge shall be billed by the City to its customers monthly at the same time that the charges provided for in Section One above are billed and the same shall constitute a part of the total electric bill of the customer and shall be due and payable at the same time as charges made under Section One above.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. The rates established by this Ordinance shall be effective for all electricity billed and collected for by the City on and after April 1, 1974.
