ORDINANCE NO. 319

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES UPON THE STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. When used in this Ordinance the term vehicle shall mean every device in, upon, or by which any personal property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any vehicle to park or permit such vehicle to be parked on any street or alley within the City of Wathena, Kansas, for more than twenty-four (24) continuous hours.

SECTION 3. That all persons violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). In addition to said penalty the City Marshal of Wathena, Kansas, is authorized and empowered to cause vehicles parked in violation of this Ordinance to be towed or removed from the streets and alleys of the City of Wathena and all vehicles so towed or removed shall remain impounded by the City Marshal until the costs and expenses of such towing or removing have been paid.

SECTION 4. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the Wathena Times, official City newspaper.
