

ORDINANCE NO. 328

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR LICENSEES, MANAGERS OR EMPLOYEES OF CERTAIN CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS TO PERMIT CERTAIN PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS IN SAID ESTABLISHMENT AFTER 8 O'CLOCK P.M. AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA:


SECTION I. That from and after the effective date of this Ordinance it shall be unlawful for the licensee, manager or any employee of any place of business or establishment primarily engaged in the sale and dispensation of Cereal Malt Beverages, (3.2% beer) and commonly known as a tavern, to permit, knowingly or unknowingly, any person under the age of eighteen (18) years in said licensed establishment after the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., unless such person is accompanied by his or her parent or legal guardian.

SECTION II. That all persons violating this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-five and No/100 Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00).

SECTION III. That Ordinance No. 239 of the City of Wathena is hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance shall become final and take effect from and after its publication in the Official City paper.
