## ORDINANCE NO. 343

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, ESTABLISHING AN EMPLOYEE BENEFITS CONTRIBUTION FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA:

SECTION 1. The City of Wathena, Kansas, does hereby establish an Employee Benefits Contribution Fund for the purpose of paying the employer's share of all employee benefits referred to in Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 2. The employer's share of the cost of employee benefits authorized for payment from the Employee Benefits Contribution Fund created by Section 1 hereof shall include payments for the following:

- (a) Kansas Public Employees Retirement;
- (b) Kansas State Unemployment Tax;
- (c) Federal Insurance Contributions Tax;
- (d) Health and Accident Insurance;
- (e) Workers' Compensation.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 67 and Chapter 163 of the 1978 Session Laws of Kansas.
