

Ordinance No. 38

An ordinance attaching territory to the City of Wathena, Kansas.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

Sec. 1 That the corporate limits of the City of Wathena, Kansas, be and the same is hereby extended as follows: Beginning at a point in the center of Sherman Street where said street is intersected by Arch street, thence west to Race street; thence south on the east side of Race Street to the south line of Seward street, thence west on the south side of Seward street to the west line of the northeast quarter of section twenty-eight (28) township three (3), range twenty-two (22) east; thence south on said line to the south line of the right of way of the Saint Joseph and Grand Island Railway thence in a southeasterly direction along said south line of said right of way to the south line of the northeast quarter of section twenty-eight (28) township three (3) range twenty-two (22) east to the line of the present city limits.

Sec. 2. That the extension of the corporate limits described in section one (1) of this ordinance shall include blocks numbered seven (7), eleven (11), twelve (12), twenty-five (25), twenty-six (26), twenty-seven (27), twenty-eight (28), twenty-nine (29), thirty (30), forty-three (43), forty-eight (48), and that part of the rights of way of the Saint Joseph and Grand Island and the Chicago Rock Island and Pacific Railways lying the northeast quarter of section twenty-eight (28) township three (3) range twenty-two (22) east, all in North Wathena, Kansas.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor and publication in the Wathena Republican.
