ORDINANCE NO. 383

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS CREATING AND DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF URINATING IN PUBLIC AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. URINATING IN PUBLIC DEFINED: Urinating in public is the act of discharging urine from the human body, in or on any street, alley, parking lot or other public place other than in a facility specifically provided for such purposes or done on private property without the consent of the owner or occupier of such private property.

SECTION 2. PENALTY: Any person convicted of urinating in public within the City of Wathena as defined by Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or by confinement for a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and confinement.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city paper.
