## ORDINANCE NO. 395

AN ORDINANCE ANNULLING, VACATING AND DISCONTINUING A PORTION OF OAK STREET, ALSO KNOWN AS CHASE STREET, IN SMALLWOOD'S ADDITION, TO THE ORIGINAL TOWN, NOW CITY OF WATHENA, DONIPHAN COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Wathena, Kansas, has deemed it necessary and expedient to annul, discontinue and legally vacate the hereinafter described portion of Oak Street, also known as Chase Street:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA:

SECTION 1. That the hereinafter described portion of Oak Street, also known as Chase Street, situate in Smallwood's Addition to the Original Town, now City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, to wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 12 in Block 3, in Smallwood's Addition to the Original Town, now City of Wathena, thence West to the Southwest corner of Lot 7 in Block 3, in Smallwood's Addition to the Original Town, now City of Wathena, thence South 30 feet, thence East 240 feet to a point 30 feet South of the point of beginning, thence North 30 feet to the point of beginning,

be and the same is hereby annulled, discontinued and legally vacated.

SECTION 2. That immediately after this Ordinance shall become effective, the City Clerk of the City of Wathena, Kansas, shall file a copy thereof, which has been duly certified by him as a true and correct copy, in the office of the County Clerk of Doniphan County, Kansas, and in the office of the Register of Deeds of Doniphan County, Kansas, as is required by the provisions of K.S.A. 15-427.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance and the annullment, discontinuance and legal vacation of the above described Street shall be effective from and after publication of said Ordinance in THE WATHENA TIMES, official City paper.
