

Ordinance No. 41

An Ordinance Providing for Building a Sidewalk on Moss Street and Appropriating Money to Build Same.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

Sec. 1 That a sidewalk be built on the west side of Moss Street adjoining Lot twelve (12) in Block twenty-two (22) in the original town (now city) of Wathena.

Sec. 2 Said sidewalk shall be constructed of oak planks two inches thick of oak planks two inches thick laid lengthwise, to be three feet wide, laid on oak stringers four feet apart.

Sec. 3 The sum of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of the city's general fund for the construction of said sidewalk.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and its publication in the Wathena Republican.
