ORDINANCE NO. 412

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, PRESCRIBING HOURS OF CLOSING FOR ESTABLISHMENTS LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IN THE ORIGINAL AND UNOPENED PACKAGE AT RETAIL AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, all establishments and places of business in the City of Wathena, Kansas, licensed to sell alcoholic liquor in the original and unopened package at retail shall be closed to the public each day between the hours of 11:00 o'clock P.M. and 9:00 o'clock A.M. the next following and during such hours of closing, no alcoholic liquor shall be sold, given away, consumed, or in any other manner disposed of in such establishments or places of business.

SECTION 2. That all persons violating this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00. Each day's violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Wathena Times official City paper.
