

Ordinance No. 42

An Ordinance Providing for Building a Sidewalk on St. Joseph Street and Appropriating for Building Same.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

Sec. 1 That a sidewalk be built on the north side of St. Joseph Street adjoining the west one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Lot three (3) and the east feet of Lot four (4) in Block fourteen (14) in the original town (now city) of Wathena.

Sec. 2, Said sidewalk shall be constructed of cement concete and be ten feet in width and be so constructed that the west ten feet of said sidewalk may be used as a wagon crossing.

Sec. 3. The sum of eighty dollars (\$80.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the city's general fund for the construction of said sidewalk.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and its publication in the Wathena Republican.
