

ORDINANCE NO. 423

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 1989 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF WATHENA; PROVIDING FOR THE TERMINATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS RELATING TO TORT LIABILITY AND THE NOXIOUS WEED PROGRAM; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WATHENA IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the 1988 Kansas Legislature amended K.S.A. 79-5021 to 79-5037 by adoption of Senate Bills 519 and 574 relating to budgets for Kansas cities; and,

WHEREAS, the aforementioned legislation takes effect on January 1, 1989; and,

WHEREAS, the special funds for tort liability and the noxious weed program have an exempt status as related to the current tax lid law but will no longer have exempt status under legislation to take effect January 1, 1989;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF TORT LIABILITY AND NOXIOUS WEED PROGRAM SPECIAL FUNDS. Effective for the 1989 budget the special noxious weed program fund and special tort liability fund are hereby terminated and all moneys related to such tax levies are authorized to be transferred into the general fund for expenditure as provided by law.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper and shall be and is effective for the 1989 budget of the City of Wathena.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances and parts of ordinances of the City of Wathena in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
