

Ordinance No. 43

An Ordinance Levying A General Tax for the Year 1908, and  
Special Sidewalk Taxes.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

Sec.1. That a tax levy of two (2) mills be assessed against all personal and real property of the City of Wathena for the year 1908, for general purposes.

Sec. 2. That a special sidewalk tax of fifty-five dollars (\$55.25) and twenty-five cents be assessed against the west hon-half (w.  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of lot three (3) and east two (2) feet of lot four (4) in block fourteen (14) in the original town, not city, of Wathena, in the county of Donipan, State of Kansas, for the payment of construction a sidewalk in accordance with Ordinance No. 42 heretofore passed for that purpose, adjoining said real estate on north side of St. Joseph street.

Sec. 3. That a special sidewalk tax of thirty-one dollars and eighty cents (\$31.80) be assessed against all of lot twelve (12) in block twenty-two (22) in the original town, now city, of Wathena, in the county of Doniphan, state of Kansas, for the payment of constructing a sidewalk in accordance with Ordinance No. 41, heretofore passed for that purpose, adjoining said real estate on west side of Moss Street.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after its publication in the Wathena Republican.
