Ordinance No. 46

Providing for the Election of Mayor, Five Councilmen and Police Judge for the City of Wathena, Kansas:

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Coucilmen of the City of Wathena:

- Sec. 1. That an election be held on Monday, April 5, 1909 in the City of Wathena, to be conducted in accordance with the laws providing therefor, for the purpose of voting for and electing the following officers, A Mayor five councilmen and a Police Judge.
- Sec. 2. Said election shall be held at the council room in the city hall and the poll shall be opened at eight o'clock a.m., and closed at six o'clock p. m.
- Sec. 3. That John Gramble, R. E. Henshaw and C. R. Singrey as judges, and Chas. A. Fetter and A. W. Thomanson as clerks are hereby appointed to conduct said election.
- Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication in the Wathena Republican.
