

ORDINANCE NO. 460

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DISCONTINUANCE OF UTILITY SERVICES SOLD AND DELIVERED BY THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS; AMENDING SECTION 3(a) OF ORDINANCE NO. 397 OF THE CITY PROVIDING FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF UTILITY SERVICES FOR NON-PAYMENT OF CHARGES; AND REPEALING THE ORIGINAL SECTION 3(a) OF ORDINANCE NO. 397 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:


SECTION 1. SECTION 3(a) OF ORDINANCE NO. 397 AMENDED. Section 3(a) of Ordinance No. 397 of the City of Wathena is hereby amended to read as follows, to wit:

"(a) In the event that any statement of charges for utility services shall remain unpaid in whole or in part after the tenth day of the month in which the unpaid statement was issued, it shall be the duty of the City Clerk to mail immediately to the customer, at the last known address as shown on the City records, a notice of delinquency and discontinuance."

SECTION 2. REPEALER. Section 3(a) of Ordinance No. 397 of the City of Wathena and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
