

ORDINANCE NO. 486

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WATHENA EXTENDING THE EXISTING CABLE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT OF FALCON CABLEVISION.

WHEREAS, Falcon Cablevision (hereafter referred to as "Falcon") provides cable television service to residents of the City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas (hereafter referred to as the "City"); and,

WHEREAS, the City desires Falcon to continue providing uninterrupted cable TV service to its subscribers in the City pursuant to a previously granted cable television franchise; and,

WHEREAS, the interests of the residents of the City will be served by granting an extension of Falcons franchise to provide cable service within the City pending negotiations relating to renewal of the franchise; and,

WHEREAS, the City and Falcon will retain all of their respective legal rights and responsibilities under the franchise and under applicable federal, state and local law;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:


SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF CABLE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT. The cable television franchise under which Falcon has previously been operating in the City is hereby extended through and including March 1, 1997.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in The Wathena Times.
