Ordinance No. 51

An Ordinance Providing for Building a Sidewalk on St. Joseph Street and Appropriating Money for Building Same.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

- Sec. 1. That a sidewalk be built on the north side of St. Joseph Street adjoining the west one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of lot three (3) in block twelve (12) in the original town of Wathena, now city.
- Sec. 2. Said sidewalk shall be constructed of cement concrete, ten(10) feet wide, as specified as a sidewalk of the first class, in Ordinance No. 44.
- Sec. 3. That the Street Commissioner is hereby authorized to establish a grade for said walk and superintend the constructing same.
- Sec. 4. The sum of Forty (\$40.00) Dollars, or as much as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the city general fund for the construction of said sidewalk.
- Sec. 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it passage, approval by the Mayor and publication in The Wathena Republican.
