

ORDINANCE NO. 523

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING GARAGE SALES IN THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WATHENA IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

Section 1. GARAGE SALE DEFINED. Garage sale shall mean and include all sales entitled "garage sale", "lawn sale", "attic sale", "basement sale", "yard sale", "rummage sale" or any similar casual sale of tangible personal property which is displayed or advertised by any means whereby the public at large is or can be made aware of the sale.

Section 2. LIMITATIONS. Garage sales shall not exceed three (3) consecutive days in duration nor shall sales occur more than three (3) times each year at any particular residential location. No garage sale shall begin before 7:00 a.m. nor continue beyond 8:00 p.m.

Section 3. APPLICATIONS. A garage sale application shall be filed at the City Office and a fee of \$2.00 will be assessed for the permit.

Section 4. PENALTIES. Any person, association, or corporation who violates the terms of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each day the violation occurs.

Section 5. REPEALER. All ordinances of the City of Wathena, Kansas, and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication in the official city newspaper.
