

ORDINANCE NO. 569

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, LEVYING A CITY RETAILERS' SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE PERCENT (1%) WITHIN THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A MUNICIPAL POOL, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2006.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. A majority of the electors voting thereon having approved, at a special question election held on the 4th day of April, 2006, the levying of a retailers' sales tax in the City of Wathena, Kansas, for the purpose of constructing a municipal pool, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.*, as amended, there is hereby levied a city retailers' sales tax in the amount of one percent (1%) to take effect on the 1st day of October, 2006.


SECTION 2. Except as may otherwise be provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailers' sales tax shall apply to such city retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published in the official city newspaper, and a copy duly certified shall be submitted to the State Director of Taxation.
