

Ordinance No. 62

An Ordinance Prohibiting and Suppressing Billiard Tables, Pool Tables, Pool Rooms, and Pool Halls, Box Ball, or Bowling Alleys within the City limits of Wathena, Kansas and fixing the punishment for the violation of said ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep or maintain in the City of Wathena, Kansas, any billiard hall, pool hall, pool room, box ball or bowling alleys where persons are allowed to play billiards or pool; or to keep or maintain any billiard table or tables, or any pool table or tables or box ball or bowling alleys upon which games of any kind are played.

Provided, That this ordinance shall not prohibit any person from keeping a billiard table or pool table, box ball or bowling alley in his or her private residence.

Sec. 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of the ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in the sum of not less than Ten Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars.

Sec. 3. Ordinance No. 60, and all ordinances and parts of ordinances so far as they are in conflict with the provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in The Wathena Times.
