

Ordinance No. 64

Concerning the running at large of chickens or other domestic fowls in the city of Wathena.

Be it ordained by the mayor and council of the city Of Wathena:

Sec. 1. Whoever, being the owner or keeper of any domestic fowls, such as geese, ducks, turkeys or chickens, shall permit the same to run at large beyond his, her or their own premises, shall be subject to a fine of not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars for each offense.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall supercede Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Ordinance No. 56 and shall be in force on and after publication in the Wathena Times.
