

CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS

ORDINANCE NO. 646

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS VACATING A PORTION OF LIMESTONE STREET IN THE CITY OF WATHENA, DONIPHAN COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Wathena, Kansas has determined that vacating that portion of Limestone Street hereinafter described would promote beneficial use and development in the city, enhance the city's tax base, and generally be in the best interest of the City of Wathena, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:


SECTION 1. That the following described portion of Limestone Street, to wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the South right-of-way line of Limestone Street and the East right-of-way line of US Hwy 36, thence easterly along the South right-of-way line of Limestone Street to a point where said South right-of-way line of Limestone Street intersects the West right-of-way line of North Fifth Street, thence Northerly along the West right-of-way line of North Fifth Street to a point where such intersects the North right-of-way line of Limestone Street, thence Westerly along the North right-of-way line of Limestone Street to a point where such intersects the West right-of-way line of US Hwy 36, thence Southeasterly along the West right-of-way line of US Hwy 36 to a point where said Hwy right-of-way line intersects the South right-of-way line of Limestone Street, such being the point of beginning,


is hereby vacated, SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to reservation by the City of Wathena, Kansas of an easement for utilities over, under and upon the entire portion of Limestone Street herinabove described

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication in "The Kansas Chief", the official city newspaper.
