

Ordinance No. 88

An Ordinance Regulating the Use of the Cut Out on Motor Vehicles and Providing Penalties for its Violation.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

Sec. 1. No person shall drive or leave standing within the corporate limits of said city, any motor vehicle while the motor is running unless the said motor is exhausting into a standard muffler and said muffler shall not be cut out or open.

Sec. 2. No driver, owner, or operator of any motor vehicle shall cause or permit any unnecessary blowing of horns, or create any unnecessary noise in the operation of any motor vehicle or cause or permit any loud or boisterous talking in any motor vehicle in the corporate limits of said city.

Sec. 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, on conviction be fined in a sum not exceeding Fifty Dollars and costs.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the Wathena Times.
