

Ordinance No. 90

An Ordinance Repealing Section Two of Ordinance Number 89 and Providing for the Paying of Paving Assessments in installments, Fixing the Terms of Payment and giving Notice for Payment of Assessments.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena:

Sec. 1. That Section 2. of Ordinance No. 89 of the City of Wathena, passed and approved on the 13th day of March 1922, be and same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 2. That said levy and assessment made to pay the cost to the abutting property for the gading, paving, guttering and curbing of St. Joseph Street, of Doniphan street and of Freemont Street, shall be paid in installments instead of in one levy, which installments shall be in fifteen equal parts, the first installment shall be due and payable in 1922, as other taxes are due and payable and on installment shall be due and payable in each and every year thereafter, payable as are other taxes, until said entire assessments are paid. That if said installments are not paid when due and payable, there shall be added thereto as a further charge on the lots, blocks and parcels of ground the same penalties and interest as are levied for delinquent taxes. That the owner of any lot, block or parcel of ground liable for any such assessment may at any time within thirty days after the publication of said Ordinance No. 89, towit: the 17th day of March, 1922, pay the said assessment in full on any said lot, block or parcel of ground, to the City Treasurer and the said property so paid on shall no thereafter be liable for any further assessment for the cost of said work, nor for the bonds issued to pay said assessments."

Sec. 2. That original Section Two of said Ordinance Number 89 is hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication once in the Wathena Times.
